When has terrorism been used?

Terror has been used by one or both sides in anticolonial conflicts, Ireland and Vietnam and France and the united state, in groups over possession of a contested homeland Palestinians and Israelis.

In addition, there were several major terrorist attacks on U.S government target overseas, including military bases in Saudi Arabia -1996 -and the U.S embassies in Kenya and Tanzania - 1998-in 2000 an explosion triggered by suicid bombers caused the deaths of - 17 -sailors' aboard a U.S.

1- Three key elements:

There are three key elements - **violence, fear and intimidation** - and each element produce terror in its victims. The FBI uses this terrorism is UN law ful use of force and violence against persons or property to intimidate or coerce a Government, the civilian population, or any segment thereof, in furtherance of political social objectives. The U.S department of state defines "Terrorism" to be premeditated against non-combatant targets by sub-national groups or clandestine against.

2-Criminal act:

The strategy of terrorists is to commit acts of violence that draw the attention of the local populace, the government and the world to their cause. The terrorists plan their attack to obtain the greatest publicity, choosing a target that symbolizes what they oppose. The effectiveness of the terrorist act lies not in the act itself, but in the public's or governments' reaction to the act.

3- Perspective of terrorism:

There are three perspectives of terrorism: 1- the terrorist's 2- the victim's 3- and general publics. The phrase "one mans terrorist is another mans freedom fighter" is a view terrorists the selves would accept - terrorists don't see them selves as evil. They believe they are legitimate combatants, fighting for what they believe in, by whatever means possible. A victim of a terrorist act sees the terrorist as a criminal with no regard for human life.
