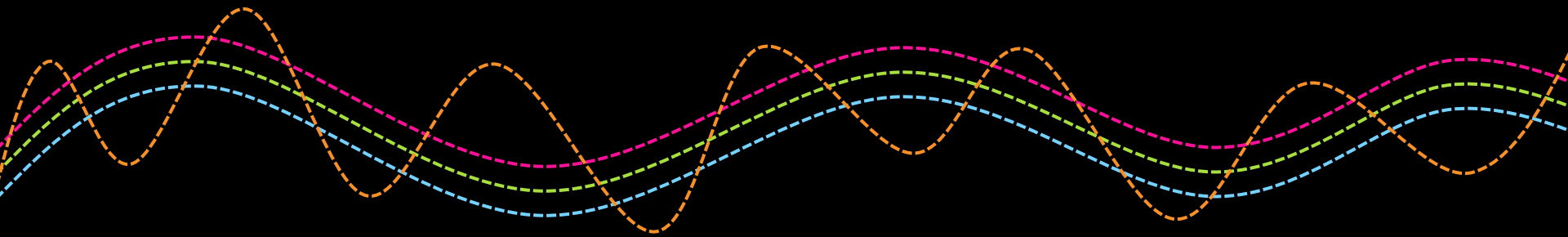

Effect of favouritism shown by teachers on G7 - G 9 students .

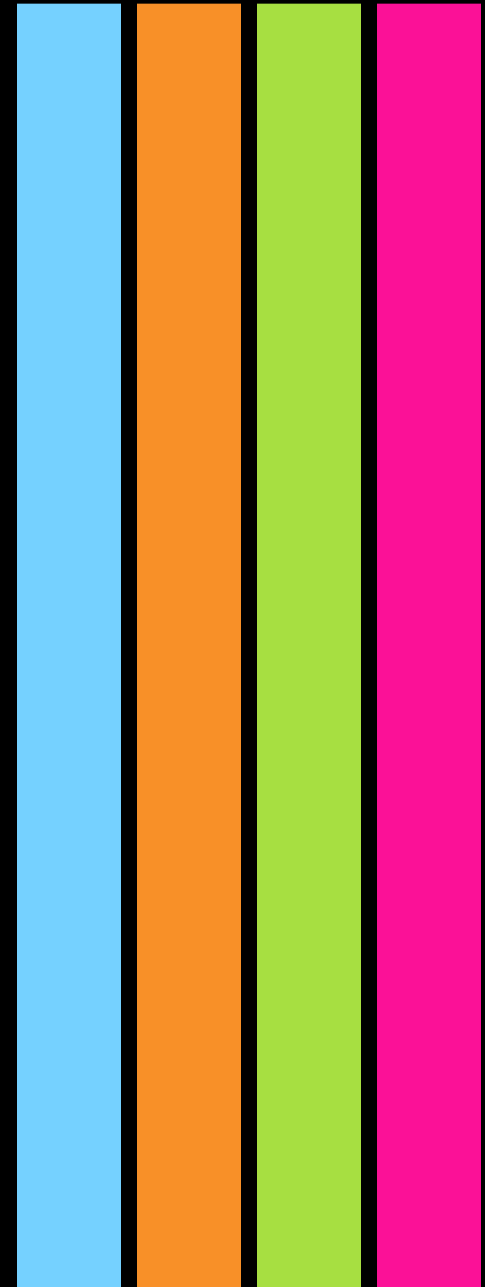

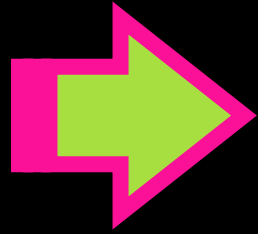
Our research question

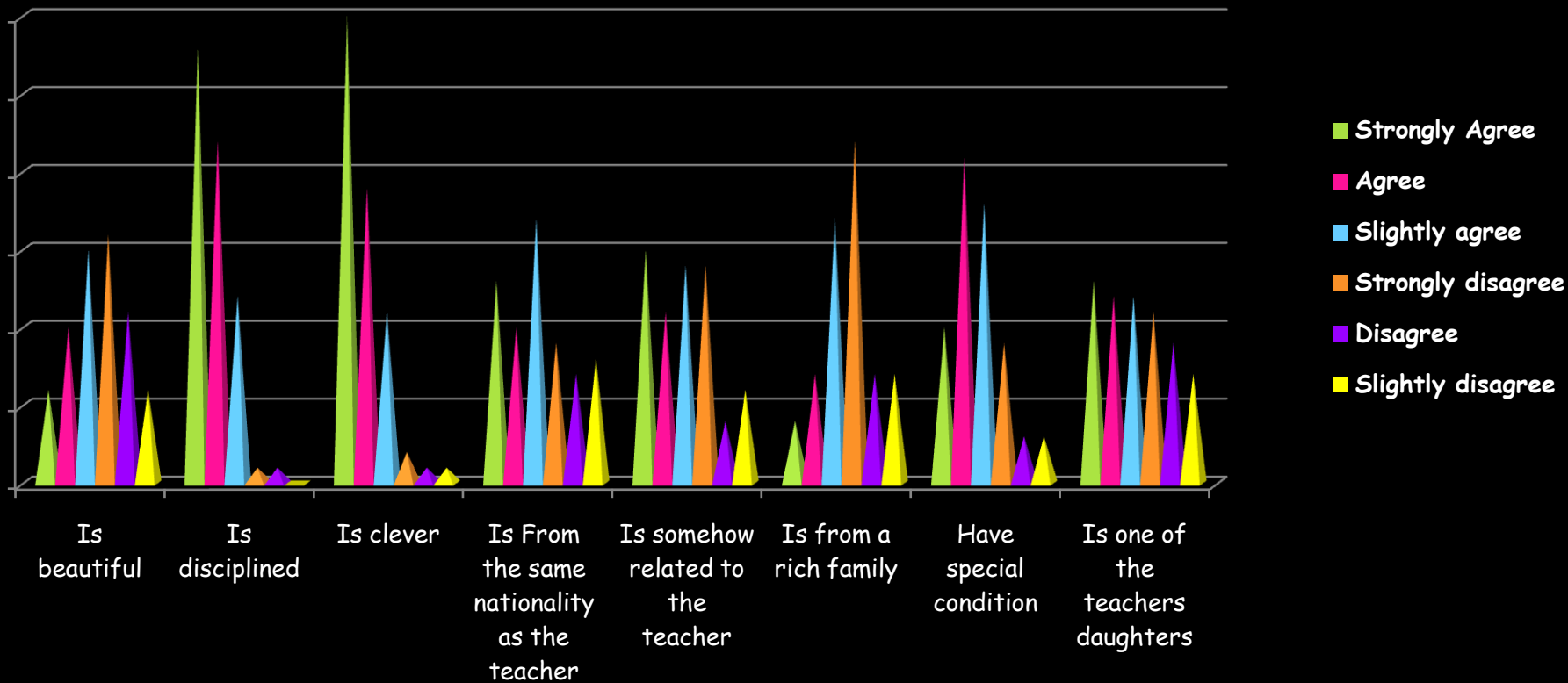
We made up the questions very carefully.

we kept everything confidential.

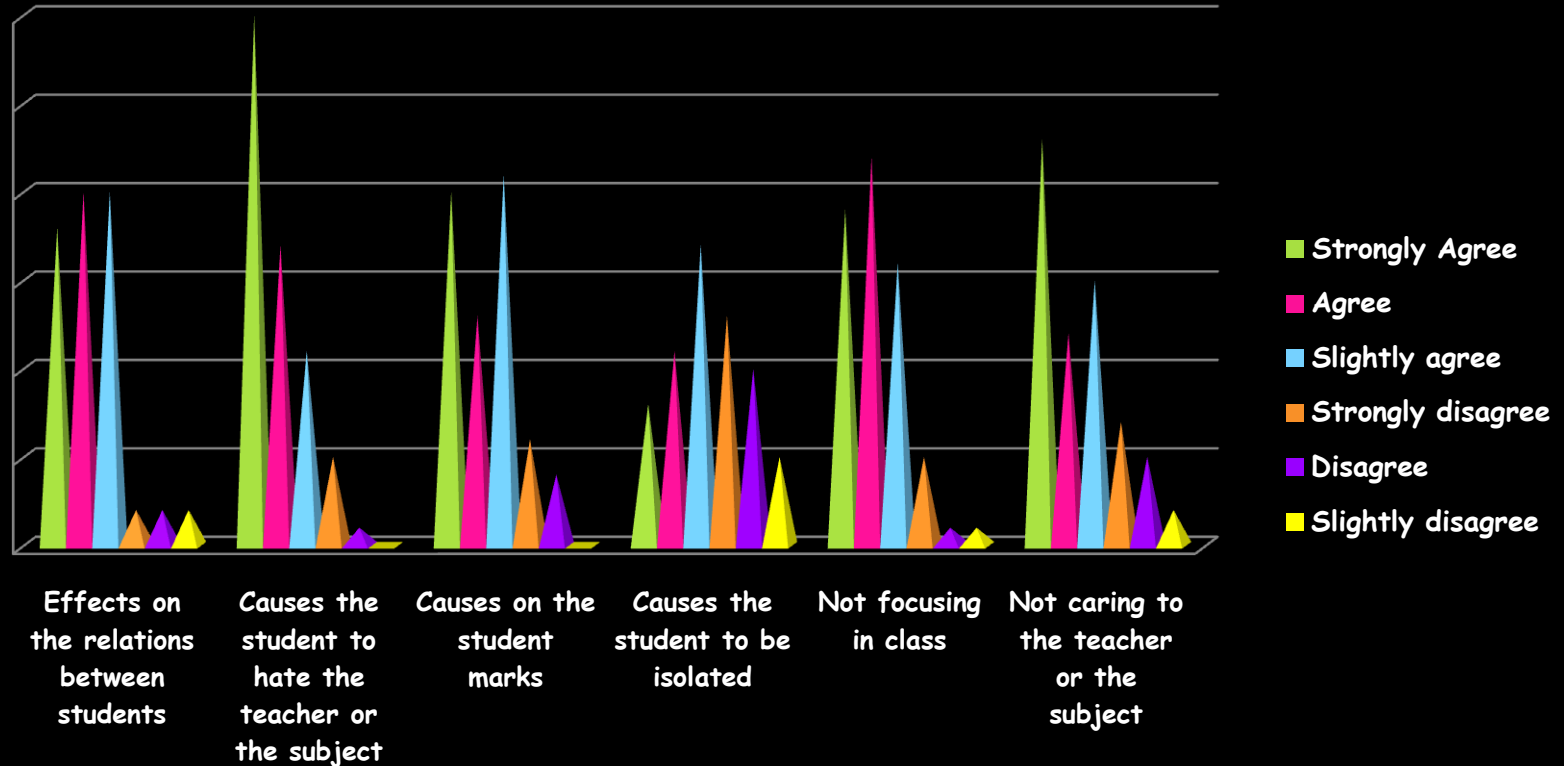
The results were accurate.

DO YOU THINK THAT A TEACHER PREFERS A STUDENT BECAUSE SHE ..



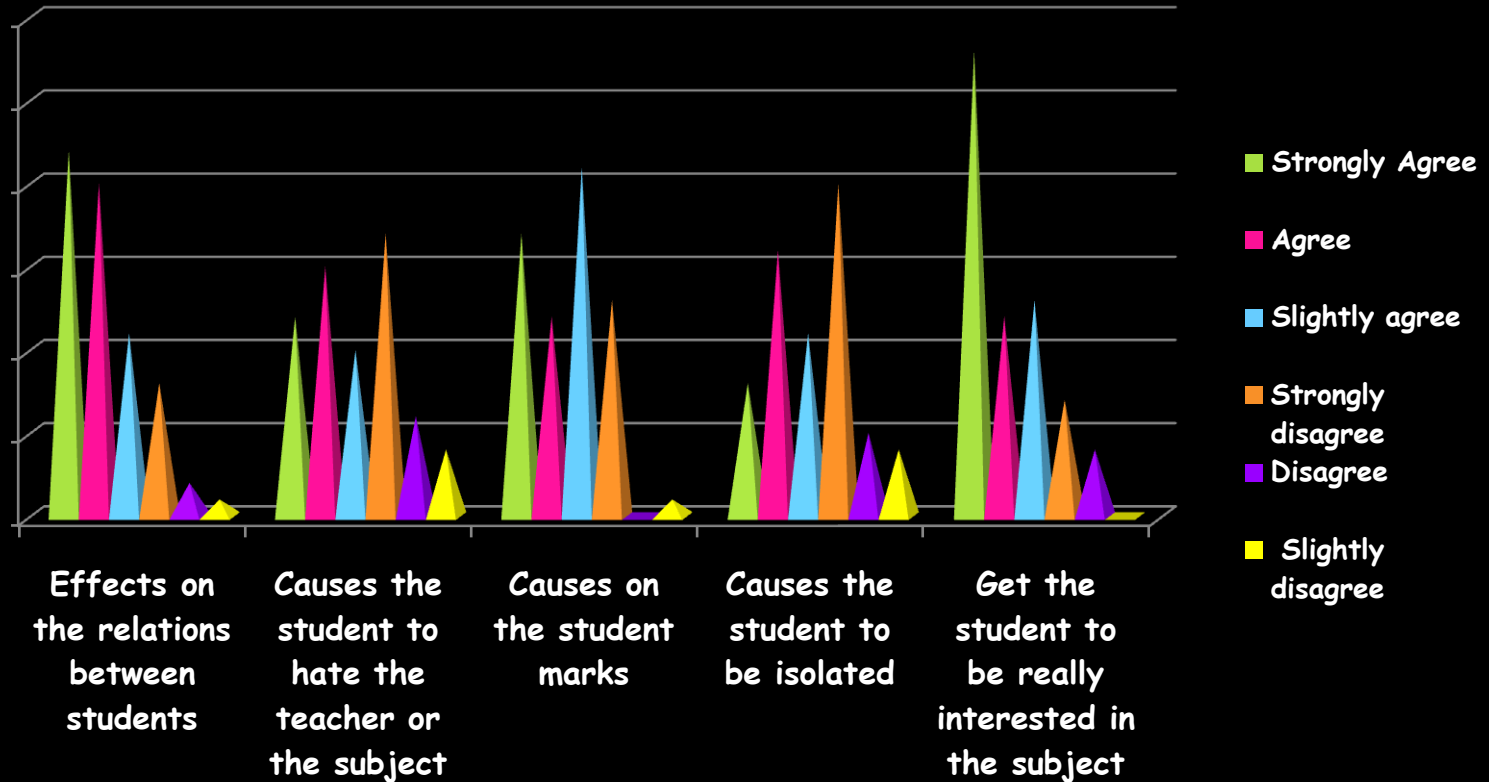

WHAT DO YOU THINK ARE THE EFFECTS ON THE OTHER STUDENT THAT IS NOT A FAVORITE?



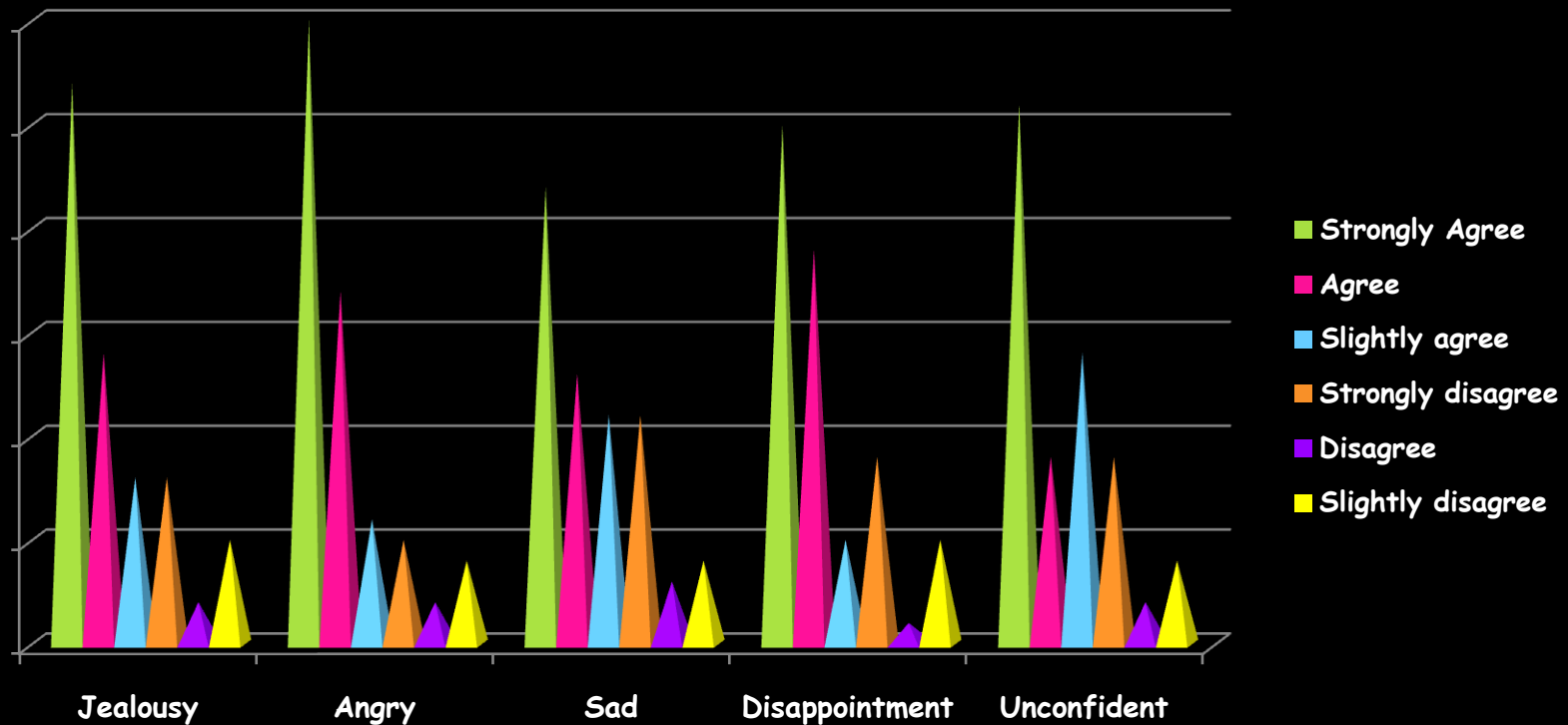
- Playing favoritism causes the other student to hate the teacher or the subject it's self .

WHAT DO YOU THINK THE EFFECTS ON THE FAVORITE STUDENT ARE?



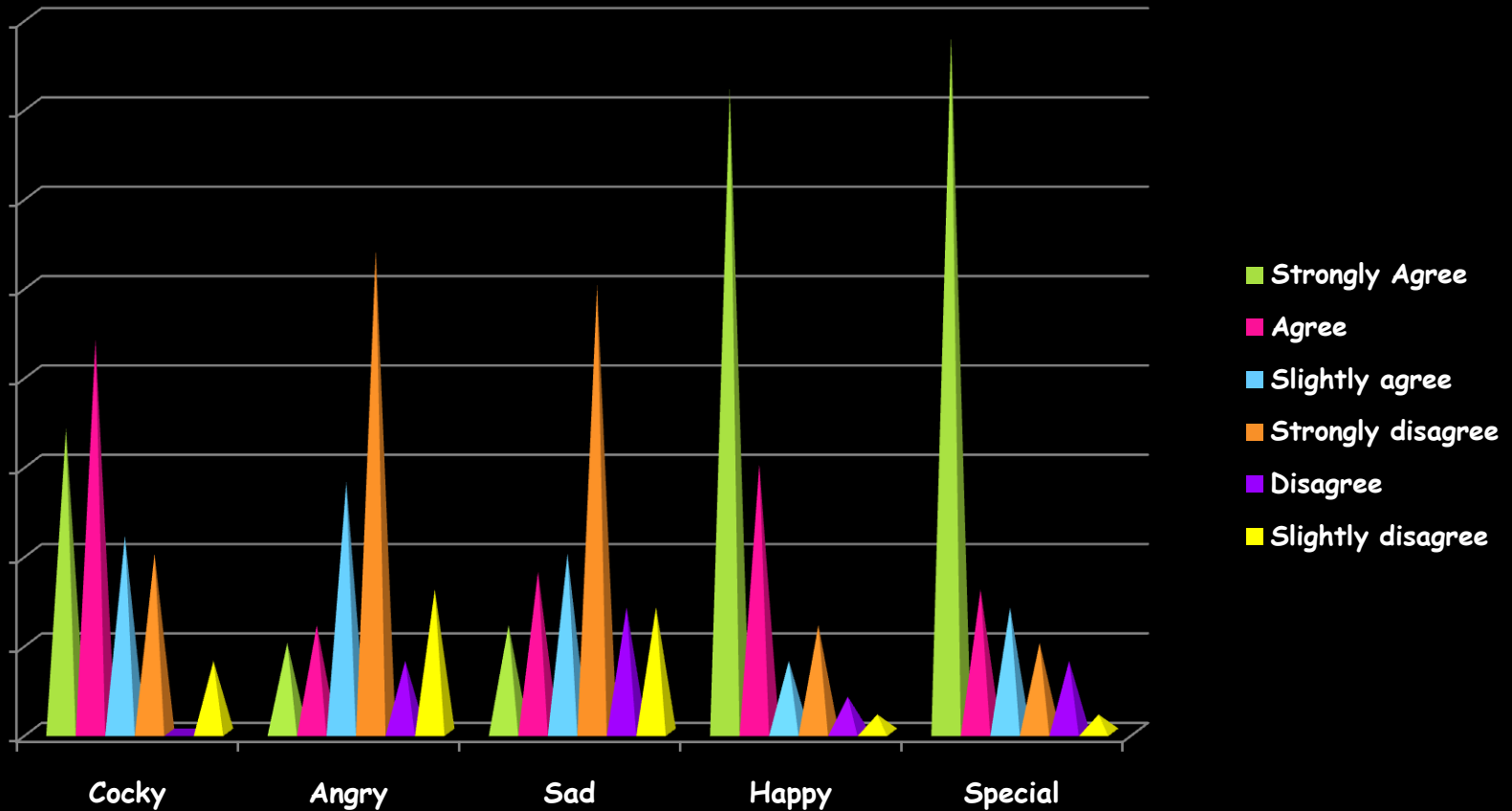
- Being a favorite student would really help to get interested in the subject .
